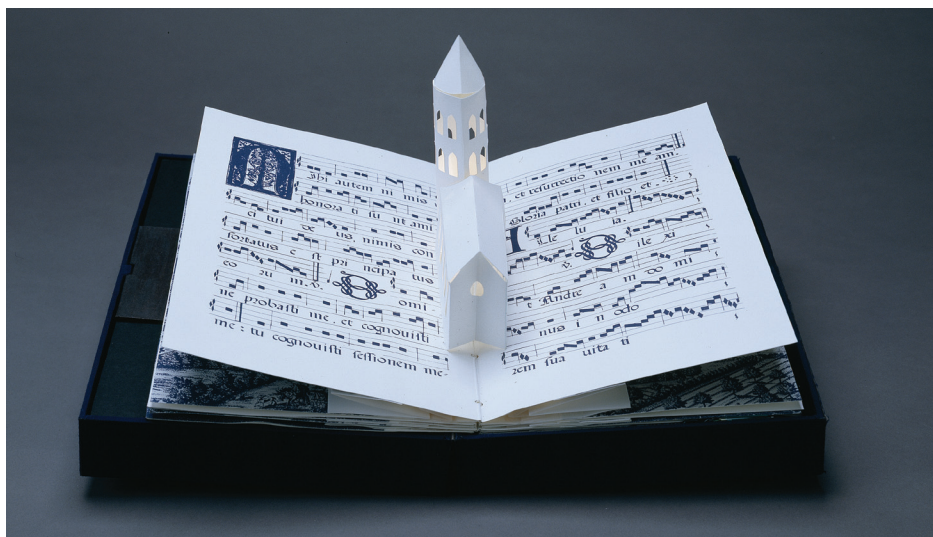
Where Books & Sculpture Meet: Carol June Barton's Artist's Books
